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Overview

Rare is the project in which a Business Analyst (BA) does only business analysis work. In today's lean environments Business Analysts are often expected to conduct some project management activities, or at the very least need to know how to work effectively within a project environment.

In today's rapidly changing market place it is also common practice for professionals to study related disciplines with a view to pursuing complementary qualifications to further their career or indeed to pursue a new career.

Course Summary

Business Analysis versus Project Management

Key activities undertaken by Business Analysts and Project Managers. Examining different skills required for each role.

Introduction to projects

Factors that contribute to project failure or success. Project management disciplines and processes that ensure repeatable delivery success. The triple constraint principle.

The project life cycle

The importance of following a project life cycle. Phase activities, milestones and gates. BA activities within the project lifecycle. Identifying phase deliverables.

Project planning

Scoping the project. Scheduling and managing work via the work breakdown structure and critical path. Developing estimates. Applying risk management techniques.

Project implementation and control

Tracking and controlling the project using baselines and change control management. Procurement planning, vendor selection and management. Managing project quality.

Closing the project

Conducting formal project closure and post implementation reviews. Gathering, documenting and assimilating lessons learnt.
