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Overview

PRINCE2 Agile® is the world's most complete project management solution, combining the flexibility and responsiveness of agile with the governance of PRINCE2®.

PRINCE2 is the most commonly used project management approach in the world, and it is increasingly being used in conjunction with agile. As more organisations adopt agile, the need for specific guidance on how to use PRINCE2 in an agile context has grown accordingly. In simple terms, PRINCE2 and agile each have their own strengths and when combined they complement each other and create a holistic approach to managing projects.

The strength of PRINCE2 lies in the areas of project direction and project management. However, it provides little focus on the field of product delivery. Conversely, agile has a very strong focus on product delivery but relatively little on project direction and project management. Therefore, when PRINCE2 and agile are combined, all three areas are addressed.

Foundation Course Objectives

PRINCE2 Agile Foundation certificate is designed to help professionals deliver agile projects by tailoring PRINCE2 management controls with a broad toolset of agile delivery techniques and frameworks.

Practitioner Course Objectives

This course examines how PRINCE2 and agile methods can interact and be adapted to accommodate each other to benefit the overall management of projects. It will help experienced project practitioners tailor PRINCE2 management controls for agile development.

Overview of agile

Introduction to the agile manifesto. Comparison of waterfall versus incremental delivery methods. Overview of key agile behaviours, concepts and techniques.

Who should attend?

PRINCE2 Agile is suitable for anyone who delivers projects, large or small, in an agile context. It is a valuable training and certification scheme for anyone working within an agile project environment, whether they be a project manager, project support, project governance or part of the wider project team.

Prerequisites

To ensure your outcomes are achieved **some pre-course preparation** is required for both the Foundation and Practitioner courses. Pre-course work will be sent out 2 weeks prior to course commencement for the Foundation Course and at the end of the Foundation Course for the Practitioner course.

Pre-requisite options for PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner are:

- PRINCE2* Foundation accreditation or higher OR
- PRINCE2 Agile Foundation accreditation

*Note: PRINCE2 2009 or 2017 required.

Development Units

Participants who have been awarded the Project Management Professional (PMP)® credential by the Project Management Institute (PMI)® are eligible to earn PDUs for their participation in this course as follows:

- » **Foundation** course: **21 PDUs** (21 Technical)
- » **Practitioner** course: **21 PDUs** (14 Technical, 5 Strategic and Business Management and 2 Leadership)

Participants holding any of the Project Management accreditations (CPPP/ CPPM/ CPPD) are eligible to earn **20 CPDs** for this short course.

Course Delivery

Trainers of this course will use a practical delivery approach to provide participants with a 'hands-on', multi-faceted and challenging learning experience. Understanding and recall techniques will be used to provide participants with a solid understanding of PRINCE2 Agile.

Foundation Certification

The course includes the PRINCE2 Agile Foundation examination which consists of:

- » 50 multiple choice questions
- » 55% pass mark (28/50)
- » 1-hour duration
- » Closed book

The Foundation exam is undertaken on the afternoon of day 3 of the Foundation course.

Practitioner Certification

The course includes the PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner examination which consists of:

- » Multiple choice, Objective test Exam (OTE)
- » 50 questions, each worth one mark
- » 60% pass mark (30/50)
- » 2.5 hours duration
- » Open book exam (PRINCE2 Agile guide only)

The Practitioner exam is undertaken taken on the afternoon of day 3 of the Practitioner course

The PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner certificate is valid for three years, at the end of which you will need to either resit the Practitioner exam OR you can maintain your certificate through a subscription to My PRINCE2.
