Point to Point (P2P) Transport

CHALLENGE

After significant change to this industry sector, new legislation was enacted to modernise the way this sector is regulated. A decision was also made to establish a new, independent regulator who would implement and ensure compliance to the new regulatory framework. PM-Partners group was engaged by Transport for NSW to conduct an initial discovery review to determine the best way to set-up a programme to establish the new Commission along with the required business processes, IT systems changes and stakeholder management. Over 90 set-up actions were identified, and PM-Partners was also selected to assist the new P2P Commissioner and her leadership team to stand-up the new Commission.
