Better retention

Learning online has been shown to **boost retention rates by 25%-60%** ⁶ ↗. Online courses are typically shorter and participants can revisit material and re-test their knowledge.

High engagement

With the arrival of **Virtual Instructor-Led Training (VILT)** as an alternative to pre-recorded courses, students can enjoy **stimulating, live learning experiences** with interactive quizzes, group breakouts and real-time feedback.

Compared to face-to-face, it's often **easier for introverted learners** to contribute to group discussions and collaborate with their peers in a virtual classroom, while others may prefer the idea of self-learning online.
